The following suggestions are made to serve as a guideline for parents in the selection of children's books for summer reading. It is hoped that as you browse through the library shelves that you may discover other books of even greater interest to you and your child.

Looking ahead to the fourth grade curriculum, you may also wish to select nonfiction books about the thirteen colonies and the state of Maryland (900s) and biographies on George Washington and Abraham Lincoln (B or BIO or 92), as well as other nonfiction books about science and animals (500s) arts & crafts, music, sports (700s) and poetry (800s). You may also wish to explore folk tales and fairy tales (398.2).
