### Our Camp Staff

**Camp Director - Sally Sweeney** celebrates her 10th summer as our camp's director. Ms. Sweeney will take you through the registration process, hire and supervise camp staff, plan camp activities and is on site daily throughout the summer.

**Day Camp Director - Meg Kemp**, a 2nd grade teacher in Howard County returns for her 4th summer. Ms. Kemp will direct the day-to-day activities, assist in planning, and supervise staff in addition to working directly with the campers.

**Sports Camp Director - Zach Nunn**, a Physical Education teacher in Howard County returns for this 4th summer. Mr. Nunn will plan and oversee sports activities, supervise staff and work directly with campers. Good Sportsmanship is the priority!

**Counselors** go through a rigorous selection process. They include teachers and college students who are assisted by high school age students. **All camp employees** are required to complete a full background check including fingerprinting and must provide references. In addition to our supervised Health Room suite, all management and Head Counselors are CPR/First Aid certified.

### General Information

**Location:** Trinity School, 4985 Ilchester Road  
Ellicott City, Maryland 21043

**Time:** Regular Camp Hours - 9:00 am to 3:30 pm  
Extended Hours - Before Care 7:00 - 9:00 am  
After Care 3:30 - 6:00 pm

**Lunch:** Campers may bring their own lunch or order online from a lunch service provider. Additional information will be provided at registration on our web page.

**Snacks:** We will provide a morning snack and afternoon treat. The Snack Bar will be open during lunch where campers may purchase drinks, ice cream and snacks.

**Clothing:** T-shirts, shorts and sneakers are recommended. All campers receive a Trinity Summer Camp t-shirt on the first day they attend camp.

**Swimming:** Campers will need to wear their swimwear under clothing on designated swim days. They should bring towels and extra clothing as needed. Campers should arrive at camp wearing **SUNSCREEN** everyday. Swimming is supervised by certified lifeguards. Bracelets are worn by campers who pass a swim test.

**Facilities:** All indoor activities will take place in air-conditioned space with the exception of the gymnasium which has high powered ceiling fans.

**Newsletters:** Parents will receive weekly camp newsletters with up-to-date information on camp activities.

**Medication:** Medication will be administered by the Health Care Supervisor or another certified camp employee if appropriate forms are provided by parents.

**First Day of Camp:** On your child's first day of camp you will arrive on campus and be directed to the gym where check-in will take place. Here you will meet the directors, put lunches away and receive your camp t-shirt. **CAMPERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND CAMP UNLESS ALL FORMS ARE COMPLETE AND MEDICATIONS MEET APPROPRIATE GUIDELINES.** All forms and instructions are mailed to you in your Confirmation packet after registration is received. ### Tutoring Services

Tutoring Services will be made available by Teachers currently on Staff at Trinity School. Arrangements for these services will be made directly between teachers and parents. Additional information will be provided in your registration confirmation packet.

### Refund Policy

Tuition refunds will be granted for voluntary withdrawal from Camp if requests are received before May 1, 2009. Registration fees are not refundable. Refunds are made in the form of a check.

### Enrollment Changes

One change will be made at no additional cost. Additional changes will be made at a cost of \$25 per change. All change requests are subject to availability.
