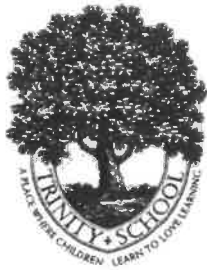

Room Parents are the key to communication with Trinity families. The Room Parent Program is sponsored by the Home & School Association (HSA). While Room Parents are always welcome to attend HSA meetings, monthly attendance is not required.

While volunteering your time and energy as a Room Parent is very rewarding, it does come with responsibilities, including:

- ❖ Help parents become better acquainted with each other and with Trinity
- ❖ Provide direct assistance to the teachers for parties, special class events and school-wide events, such as the Halloween and Valentine's Day activities
- ❖ Provide on-site assistance at key HSA events, including the Fall Festival, Staff Appreciation Luncheon and Operation Love – if you cannot personally attend an event, please enlist someone from your class to take your place
- ❖ Recruit and coordinate additional volunteers from your class to help at Trinity events
- ❖ Solicit donations from parents for events such as class parties, Fall Festival raffle items and Secret Letter
- ❖ Send out reminders/sign-up sheets about class activities and events
- ❖ Maintain a positive working relationship with your teacher and co-Room Parent(s)
- ❖ Keep an up-to-date list of contact information for all parents in your grade
- ❖ Organize teacher gifts for teacher appreciation day, end-of-year, etc.
- ❖ Promote cooperation and communication between parents, teachers and the school

FALL FESTIVAL

The Fall Festival is an HSA-sponsored fundraising event held in October that features games and activities for the kids, a Trinity Spirit sale to benefit the Trinity Scholarship Committee, a silent auction, great food, and a raffle. It is often referred to as a Welcome Back to Campus event, as we like to welcome all including our surrounding community to this event. This is the HSA's biggest fundraiser of the year.

All Grades:

- Volunteers are vital to the success of this event! A signup genius will be sent to all families, and the middle school signup (for volunteer hours) is posted outside the classrooms. Please solicit parent volunteers to help with games, food and other activities as needed.

HALLOWEEN PARTY

Typically, we have a lot of games for kids to partake in during the school day and we love parent involvement. This event is hosted by the HAS and run by Courtney Molino our Room Parent Director.

Middle School:

5th and 6th grades – One party is given for both grades. You will be notified by your room parent what the party will entail and what you can bring/drop off.

7th and 8th grades – A dance is held for these students.

Primary School (Grades 1 – 4):

The Halloween Party is a group party with various activities held outdoors. A special snack will be provided for the children by the HSA during snack time. Volunteers are needed to work on the various activities. It's a great way to see your kid have some fun and mingle with other parents and teachers.

Kindergarten & Preschool has a separate activity. Room parents will advise on what the plan is in coordination with the teachers.

SECRET LETTER

The Secret Letter is a means of collecting monetary contributions to be distributed evenly to all Trinity teachers and staff members at Christmas. In order to facilitate this, a letter is sent by the HSA to all families. This is a Trinity tradition we hold dear as it means that everyone, both faculty and staff, would receive a monetary gift during Christmas.

Middle School: Letters are distributed by the Student Council Representatives.

Primary School: Room Parents will distribute the letters to their homerooms on a date TBD (typically the Monday or Tuesday after Thanksgiving break). On that day, at least one Room Parent from each homeroom will meet to coordinate and distribute the letters.

Preschool: Letters will be provided to Barb Law for distribution via KidMail. A separate letter is sent out by Mrs. Law for TED employees, as they are not included in the Secret Letter. Room Parents have no responsibilities for the TED letter.

STAFF APPRECIATION LUNCHEON

Held in conjunction with Catholic Schools Week, this HSA-sponsored event features a luncheon and other activities to show our appreciation for our hard-working teachers and staff members. Room Parents are encouraged to volunteer and may be requested to solicit additional volunteers as necessary.

SPRING EVENT

The proceeds from this school-sponsored event support Trinity's programs and projects. It is an evening event and this year the theme is Havana Nights. It is also an adult event with no kids in attendance with dinner and entertainment. It is a must go event and tickets are sold by the Development Department at school.

OPERATION LOVE

This event is sponsored by the HSA and is a wonderful way to celebrate and honor our grandparents and other older friends and relatives. Parents are expected to volunteer at this event, solicit additional volunteers as necessary and encourage parents to purchase tickets. It is an amazing event with swag that can be won, concerts given by our students, and after the event Grandparents can take a tour of campus with their student and also view the Art Show in the middle school building.
